## Biotinylated SARS-COV-2 Spike S Trimer Protein



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#### Description Recombinant Biotinylated SARS-COV-2 Spike S Trimer Protein is expressed from HEK293 with His tag and Avi tag at the C-Terminus Source It contains Val16-Glu1188. Accession QHD43416.1 The protein has a predicted MW of 136.6 kDa. Due to glycosylation, the protein migrates to 140-170 kDa based Molecular Weight on Tris-Bis PAGE result. Endotoxin Less than 1EU per µg by the LAL method. Purity > 95% as determined by Tris-Bis PAGE Formulation and Storage Lyophilized from 0.22µm filtered solution in PBS (pH 7.4). Normally 8% trehalose is added as protectant before Formulation lyophilization. Centrifuge the tube before opening. Reconstituting to a concentration more than 100 µg/ml is recommended. Reconstitution Dissolve the lyophilized protein in distilled water. -20 to -80°C for 12 months as supplied from date of receipt. -80°C for 3-6 months after reconstitution. 2-8°C for 2-Storage 7 days after reconstitution. Recommend to aliquot the protein into smaller quantities for optimal storage. Please minimize freeze-thaw cycles. Background The spike protein (S) of coronavirus (CoV) attaches the virus to its cellular receptor, angiotensin-converting enzyme 2 (ACE2). A defined receptor-binding domain (RBD) on S mediates this interaction. The S protein plays key parts in the induction of neutralizing-antibody and T-cell responses, as well as protective immunity.


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Biotinylated SARS-COV-2 Spike S Trimer on Tris-Bis PAGE under reduced condition. The purity is greater than 95%.
